### Smoke-Free Policy

#### Smoke-Free Addendum

The St. Louis Housing Authority (SLHA) is revising its Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP) to incorporate the final rule of U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Smoke-Free Policy, (FR-5597-F-03), effective February 3, 2017. The Smoke-Free Policy and Lease Addendum bar the use of tobacco products in all public housing living units, interior common areas and outdoor areas within 25 feet from public housing.

The comment period is limited to three minutes per speaker.
