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Insert Additional Scope of Services to the RFP as follows:

Integrated Pest Management Program

Respondent shall include Pest Management Services to include a Pest Management Coordinator who will be responsible for all developments and the implementation of an Integrated Pest Management Plan and will serve as the primary point of contact for all issues related to the administration of this plan. This is a dedicated and budgeted position. Respondent shall implement, and monitor the Pest Management Program that complies with Integrated Pest Management Principles. The principles include and are not limited to identification of pest, establish monitoring guidelines, setting action thresholds, evaluating and implementation of control tactics and monitoring, evaluating and documenting the results. Monthly reporting by the respondent to the housing authority is also a required component of this program as well.
